We believe that:


We have a responsibility to safeguard the welfare of all children, young people and adults who may be at risk to keep them safe

We will seek to keep children, young people and adults who may be at risk safe by:

- Valuing, listening to and respecting them.
- Ensuring that we provide a safe physical environment for children, young people, adults and volunteers, by undertaking risk assessments and applying basic health and safety measures.
- Not using photographs of children taken at events without written parental permission.
- Raising awareness of potential safeguarding issues with the event volunteers.

We are committed to reviewing our policy and good practice annually.
